CLOSING PRAYER

For a Lent retreat using Alive in the Word Lent: Season of Transformation

Leader: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. [All make the Sign of the Cross.]

> Lord, we thank you for the gift of this time together. We give it to you as a Lenten offering, a gift of ourselves. We thank you for being with us—for speaking to our hearts, strengthening our faith, and reminding us that we are not alone on our Lenten journeys. We pray that the transformation begun in us will continue. Amen.

We will now pray a Lenten litany. After each petition, we will all respond: Transform us, Lord.

[The leader can read the petitions, or participants can take turns reading them. All respond: "Transform us, Lord."]

Leader: And now let us pray together the words that Jesus taught us.

- All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.
- Leader:Let us close our time together by sharing with one another a Sign of Peace.[Participants can greet one another and share a time of fellowship.]
